

2024 GRANT FIELD JUNIOR CLASSIC

6 HOLES RULES SHEET

The 6-hole competition is played from specially designated tee markers at both Pelican Waters Golf Club and Caloundra Golf Club.

- A maximum of 6 shots is allowed to get the ball on the green
- If a player is not on the green, pick up the ball and place it on the edge of the green. From there **a maximum of 4 putts is allowed to get the ball into the hole**. If not achieved, **pick up the golf ball and simply write 10 strokes on the scorecard**.
- If a ball is hit into the bunker, the player is allowed 1 attempt to get the ball out. If the ball doesn't get out, pick up the ball and place the ball on the grass beside the bunker, **no nearer to the hole. Only count the 1 shot they attempted**. It's considered a free drop out of the bunker.
- When on the green, the furthest ball from the hole will putt first. From there please encourage that player to continue putting out. **A maximum of 4 putts per hole is allowed per hole, regardless if a player was on the green for 1 or shots**.
- Air swings are counted as 1 stroke.
